We also need to make sure that we are all doing coursework and testing. I have **9 Sea Cadets** and **11 League Cadets** that have time in grade and time in service for their promotion, but are missing coursework, exam, PRT or a combination of the three. Let's get those promotions going this month. We need to pack up the NOSC and get ready to move to the ships; this month we will be at the *NOSC on Saturday*, but arrive at the *ships on Sunday*. We need to make sure the trucks are loaded by the time we leave on Saturday. (*Speaking of packing, someone who attended winter training left a pair of black boots at the park. If you find you are missing a pair of boots please let your chain know that I can get these back to you.)

Keep an eye towards training. I have noticed that there are a lot of trainings already listed. If you want to attend any, make sure you get on it quickly and *notify us* of your intent to go. Many of these trainings fill up quickly so you need to act fast.

<u>LTC:</u>

The following is an order:

- Have ID Cards in hand ready to present at the gate of the NOSC and Quarterdeck at the Ships.
- Have your sea bag with all the required components; This includes pen and small notebook. Canteen and belt. PT gear and socks/sneakers.
- Uniform(s) of the day should be cleaned, and worn appropriately with all components: *Uniform

*CLEAN t-shirt that is not all stretched out *cover *belt *flashes in order/worn correctly *trousers bloused *boots shined

- Be ready for inspection at Morning Muster.

I expect all cadets to have their Uniform in order. Bring a change of civilian clothing with you to drill both days as well. Also, be prepared to pack up materials from the NOSC to move back to our summer home at the ships.

Lastly, it is VERY important to log onto Quarterdeck/Polaris and do needed course work and/or study if eligible to test for promotion. Be sure to send up a chit to request to test as well. That is all.

<mark>Admin Info</mark>

Medical: If your Physical Exam is more than a year old, you need a current one on file. Your doctor must fill out the official USNSCC Medical Form that you can print out from "Homeport". Attachments from the Doctor's Office are not accepted. Current physicals are not only needed to attend Boot Camp and Advanced Training, but are necessary to maintain enrollment in the Sea Cadet program itself.

Registration/Renewal: You MUST have a current I.D. to attend training and drills, both locally and elsewhere. NO EXCEPTIONS. The system will automatically drop you from a training if your I.D. lapses. It is imperative that you pay your dues on time, so that you can be renewed as necessary.

If you haven't already been told, you will be notified at drill if any money or medical forms are due.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION, REMINDERS, AND REQUESTS

-April IS NOT an overnight drill.

-BE PREPARED TO RUN THE PRT.

-Even though April is not an overnight, BRING DEODORANT. You should still have it to put on when changing back into your uniform after PT/PRT.

-The switch to Dress **Whites** and **Summer** Salt & Peppers takes effect in May. Now is the time to be checking to see if your Summer Dress Uniforms fit. Don't wait until the last minute. It takes time for supply to pull uniforms AND make sure they fit you even if they are labeled correctly; they may have been tailored.

-Reminder: EVERY email that includes an officer as a recipient, MUST include a second officer. This is not just a unit regulation, it is a full program regulation set forth by National Headquarters. Please note: even though it's "in the name", a Petty Officer does *NOT* count as an Officer; the regulation is in regards to ADULT Officers. If you are unsure of how to "copy/cc" someone to an email, ask someone for help. It is imperative that this regulation be followed. Please use "cc", *NOT* "bcc".
